Shikoku Area pass is valid for unlimited rides on all six railways in Shikoku

- Ride Nangoku Express buses between Matsuyama and Kochi for a special discounted fare of ¥1,000 (normally ¥3,600). The trip between Matsuyama and Kochi only takes about 2 hours and 30 minutes to 3 hours by bus, which is much faster than traveling by train. The Nangoku Express is a great choice for travel between Matsuyama and Kochi. How to Get the Discount: Show your ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass at a JR Shikoku Bus Plaza. *Note that reservations cannot be made in advance and you may be unable to board if all available seating is full.
- Ride the Nankai Ferry connecting Tokushima Port and Wakayama Port for a special discounted fare of ¥1,400 (normally ¥2,000). How to Get the Discount: Show your ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass or MCO at the ferry ticket window.
- Get special discounts on Ishizaki Kisen and Setonaikaikisen ferries/high-speed ships connecting Matsuyama Port and Hiroshima Port. Ride the Super Jet for a discounted fare of ¥3,800 (normally ¥7,100) and the Cruise Ferry for a discounted fare of ¥2,000 (normally ¥3,600). How to Get the Discount: Show your ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass or MCO at the ferry ticket window along with your passport.
- By showing the ALL SHIKOKU Rail Pass to the staff, you can ride the Iyotetsu Takashimaya Ferris wheel for free (a ¥700 value). The large Ferris wheel called "Kururin," which stands atop Iyotetsu Takashimaya store, will carry its riders 85m off the ground for them to enjoy a great panoramic view that includes the Matsuyama Castle at practically eye level and the Seto Inland Sea.
